Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly's statement on removal of the Hyde Amendment from funding legislation

The Knights of Columbus is extremely disappointed in this week's actions by the House of Representatives to remove longstanding, bipartisan taxpayer and conscience protections including the Hyde Amendment. The House vote to make taxpayers pay for abortions is both an assault on the dignity of life and contrary to the wishes of most Americans. This year's Knights of Columbus/Marist polling, affirming over a decade of previous polling data, shows that 58% of Americans oppose the use of taxpayer funding for abortions. We urge the Senate to include the Hyde Amendment and other similar provisions as they undertake the appropriations process and for the full Congress to ultimately pass spending bills that affirm this bipartisan desire of the American public. We call on all legislators, especially our fellow Catholics, to have the courage to make a stand for conscience and to not force every tax-paying American to pay for the destruction of innocent life in the womb.

The Knights remain totally committed to supporting the cause of life. In the past decade, we have donated more than 1,400 ultrasound machines to pregnancy resource centers in all 50 states, and we will continue this and other efforts to build a culture of life. Fraternally,




In Loving Memory --Joe Hasulak

The K of C Corpus Christi Council is holding a golf tournament in memory of our late Brother Joseph Hasulak. The tournament will be Saturday, September 21, at the Lakes Golf Course. It will be a shotgun start and a scramble scoring. Fee will be \$25, which provides green fee, buffet, prize and donation. Last day for registration will be September 16. You may register before and after all Masses or at the Lakes Club House.



Recruiting Incentive Announced

At the AZ Council Organization meeting the State Membership Chairman announced the new Incentive Program for recruiting new members. The program was created by the AZ Council for all active councils and members in the state. It includes newly created pins and cash incentives. If a members signs up one member he receives the Blue Star Recruiter Pin. When he signs up five new members he receives the Red Recruiter Pin. When he signs up ten members he will receive a Gold Recruiter Pin. The pins are displayed in the attached picture. Our council quota is 16 new members, and we have 3 prospects already.

Any council receiving 50% of their yearly goal set by Supreme by the end of September will earn a \$50 cash award. Another cash award of \$75 for 75% of their goal by the end of December. Any Council that meets their annual Membership Quota by the end of December will receive \$100 off their State per capita bill which is a total of \$225 for the councils.

Any current members who signs up 5 new members by November 15, will be entered into a raffle drawing to win a free registration and meals for himself and a guest at the State Council Mid-Year meeting.

There are other cash awards for councils, but they all start with our members recruiting new members. Ask not only your family members but also Parish members, and friends in Catholic Schools and the Community.

In the past members were asked to recruit new members. This is the first time the AZ Council has offered incentives for recruiting. Good luck and let's see who earns the most pins in our council.

Diocese of Phoenix Safe Environment Training

The Diocese of Phoenix is committed to protecting all children and youth by offering, at all Diocesan parishes, several abuse prevention educational sessions. The Diocesan Policy and Procedure for the Protection of Minors requires all clergy, employees, volunteers that directly serve minors, and minors to attend training on an annual basis. All other volunteers in the parish must attend Safe Environment training every other year. In Catholic education grades Pre-k through high school, every student every year participates in a Safe Environment program.

In the Diocese of Phoenix all adult volunteers must complete Called to Protect for Ministries as a foundation course for Safe Environment. Called to Protect for Ministries is a 3 hour program which will teach steps that can be taken to prevent child sexual abuse and as a component of the training everyone is required to complete a volunteer application and Code of Ethics.

A 45 minute renewal Training is offered for all subsequent years. This training is offered through in-class sessions at the parish or through computer "online" training.




